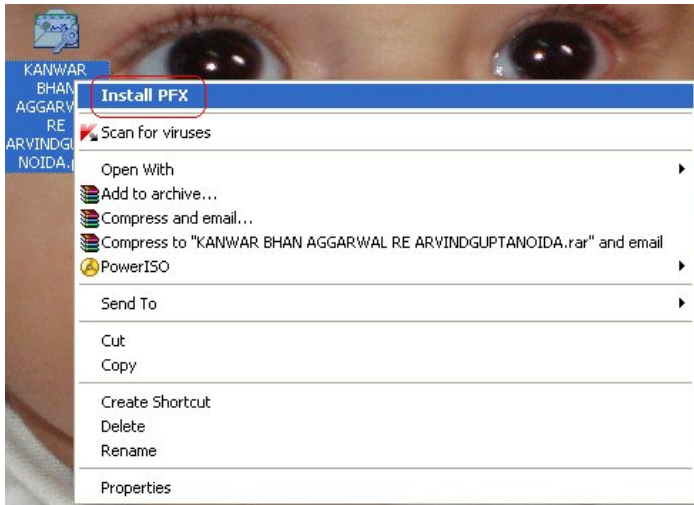

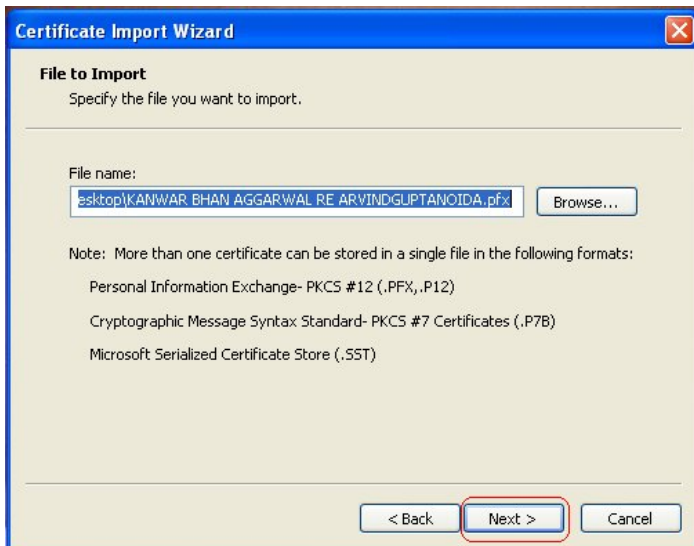

1. Right Click on the .pfx file and Click on "Install PFX". And follow the steps as shown in picture below.




Click on Next .

To maintain security, the private key was protected with a password.


